# Rolling Stones' 'Crossfire' film on DVD/Blu-ray May 21

*The 2012 documentary emphasizes the band's early years and rise to superstardom.*



Fans who get squeezed out of the stampede for Rolling Stones tour tickets can opt for the couch and a copy of *Crossfire Hurricane*.

The 2012 documentary, directed by Brett Morgen, premiered at the London Film Festival in October, had an HBO run and will be released on DVD (\$15) and Blu-ray (\$20) on May 21 by Eagle Rock Entertainment. The pre-order date is April 26.

The critically acclaimed film chronicles the Stones' early chapters, from their teen years as blues-crazed unknowns through their rise in the early '60s to superstardom in the '70s. Viewers spy the Stones in tiny venues (the Marquee Club, site of their first gig more than 50 years ago), at pivotal events (Altamont) and in the huge stadiums that have defined their recent past.

In addition to previously unreleased footage, *Crossfire* serves up commentary from Mick Jagger, Keith Richards, Charlie Watts, Ronnie Wood and former members Bill Wyman and Mick Taylor.
